

General Bravo Instructions

- 1. You may resume normal daily activities and your normal diet once feeling better from sedation after the procedure.
- 2. Do not chew gum or eat hard candy during the study.
- 3. Remain on your acid reducer medication (PPI), unless directed otherwise by your provider.
- 4. <u>Do not</u> get the recorder wet.
- 5. <u>Do not turn the BRAVO recorder "OFF" at any time.</u>
- 6. Keep the BRAVO recorder close by you at all times, at least be within 3 feet of the recorder.
- 7. Document on the patient diary all the hours that you are sleeping Example: Slept from 10pm 6am

 Nap from 1pm 2pm
- 8. Document your meals, activities, acid reducing medication use, & symptoms on diary sheet.
- 9. Bring recorder and completed diary sheet to Huron Gastro Office after <u>96hrs</u> of reading.

You must return the recorder back to our office as note above

our office closes at 5pm, so please return before closing time

- 10. You can expect the pH capsule to fall off and be released from the body within 7-10 days from the procedure. You do not need to retrieve it; it can be safely flushed down the toilet.
- 11. No MRI during or after the study for 30 days.
